Qualifications and requirements for the different work areas:

POSITION 1:

- A good understanding of European policy development with regard to migration and asylum, and against racism and discrimination will be important

POSITION 2:

- A demonstrated knowledge of project development, management and budget planning. Experience of successful fundraising as well as track record in financial and narrative reporting and a basic understanding of project accounts is necessary

FOR BOTH POSITIONS:

- Computer literacy and command of office programmes are required
- The working language is English, and therefore a good command of written and spoken English is required; additional European languages, particularly French and/or German, are an asset
- Experience of communication ongoing work and results using a variety of media is an asset
- An understanding of churches´ involvement in work for and with refugees, migrants and minority ethnic people would be an advantage
- Candidates are expected to identify with the mission of the organisation¹ⁱⁱⁱ.
